Every day new partners join us and our mission is clear: We want that in every garage, in every living room, in every office and conference room, in every workshop and at every professional race team and in other places a racetrack decorates the wall.

Our racetracks are made of plywood and come with a film faced surface and are available in black, blue or red. We offer our racetracks in 3 sizes – 23 cm (9 inch), 46 cm (18 inch) and 92 cm (36 inch) width.

Our customers can choose between more than 700 racetracks from all over the world.

If there is a racetrack missing in our range, we only need a graphic and can produce it within a few hours.

Materials

The most important raw material for plywood is the regrowing natural resource timber. The main raw materials for the production of plywood are the Finnish birch (Betula pendula, hardwood) and the spruce (Picea abies, softwood).

Our race tracks are made of Finnish birch. We only use premium plywood which is coated with phenol resin.


The plywood we get from Finland is FFCS (The Finnish Forest Certification System) certified. This national forest certification system FFCS reliably proves that the forests are cultivated according to the principles of sustainable development.





The finish FFCS forest certification system has the approval of the PEFC system (The Pan-European Forest Certification). The PEFC environment label you can see on our timber products or their packaging guarantees that the wooden material comes from forests which have the FFCS system certification. This requires the monitoring of the whole process of acquiring the timber and manufacturing.
